SYNOPSIS:

Over a period of three days (02/10/12 through 02/13/12), Lindsay [REDACTED] was falsely imprisoned inside an apartment and forced by a man named Scotty to have sex with three other men. During her captivity, Scotty raped [REDACTED] twice before she escaped.

ORIGIN:

On 02/13/12 at 2215 hours, I responded to a radio call to investigate a rape at the Denny's at Hancock Street and Camino Del Rio West. The reporting person, Lindsay [REDACTED] said she was waiting there for police in Yellow Cab #115.

INVESTIGATION:

When I arrived at the scene, I found [REDACTED] waiting in the cab in the Denny's parking lot. I first spoke to the cab driver, Bashir Abdisalan, and released him from the scene after obtaining his statement (see below). I spoke to [REDACTED] and obtained a preliminary statement of what had occurred. [REDACTED] agreed for me to transport her to the Western Division station, where I continued interviewing her about the crime (see her statement below). [REDACTED] and I sat at a desk during the interview. While we spoke, I conducted computer checks of the name "Scott Bradley" (which [REDACTED] believed to be the name of the man who raped and pimped her). When I could not locate a record of anyone by that name, I conducted a check of "Scott" at 4555 Vandever Avenue. I discovered a record of Scott Bradley Espinosa (DOB: 06/09/80) living at 4555 Vandever Avenue #18B. A photograph of Espinosa appeared on the computer screen as I conducted the check. I did not say anything or present the photograph to [REDACTED] to view, but she was seated next to me because I was speaking to her while I used the computer. Upon seeing the photograph, [REDACTED] stood up from her chair, looked closer at the computer screen, and said, "That's him."

I viewed the Cricket cell phone (phone number (619) 381-3903 [REDACTED] had in her possession. On it I saw three similar photographs of [REDACTED] in a miniskirt bent over a bed with her bare buttocks pointed toward the camera. There were also several incoming text messages in which people from different phone numbers wrote things similar to "How much for a BJ?," "Nice pic," "I like your Back Page," and other messages with references to roses. There were several outgoing text messages that also referred to roses and appeared to be negotiation communications in response to the incoming text messages. All the text messages were from 02/13/12.

While obtaining [REDACTED] statement, detectives from the Vice and Sex Crimes Units arrived to interview [REDACTED] (see the related investigative report). Because the detectives began their own interview of

[REDACTED], the below statement is a synopsis of the crime only and lacks several details. After the interview, Detective Shebloski #5317 gave me a paper bag which he said contained [REDACTED] panties. I took custody of the bag. Detectives transported [REDACTED] to 4555 Vandever Avenue to identify the apartment. I transported [REDACTED] from the apartment complex to 4276 54th Place #C, where she underwent a sexual assault examination. Officer Carpenter #5429 relieved me at the location of the examination and I impounded the panties at Headquarters.

BACKGROUND:

None.

STATEMENTS:

Statement of Bashir Abdisalan (Witness):

Abdisalan was dispatched at about 2200 hours by his cab company to pick up a fare from the Chili's restaurant near Camino Del Rio North. Abdisalan did not know who called for a cab. When he arrived, [REDACTED] walked out of the restaurant and asked him, "Did they pay you?" Abdisalan asked, "Who?" [REDACTED] said, "Hold on," and walked back into the restaurant. She came back out about three minutes later and told Abdisalan somebody had hurt her and she did not have money to pay him. She told him she was trying to go to the Denny's restaurant near Hancock Street and Rosecrans Street. Abdisalan had to go to the Yellow Cab Company in Point Loma anyway in order to deliver his credit card receipts, so he decided to drive her because Denny's is nearby. Abdisalan told [REDACTED] that she should call the police to report whatever had happened to her. [REDACTED] said she did not want to talk to the police.

When they arrived at Denny's, [REDACTED] offered Abdisalan a cell phone as payment for the ride. Abdisalan had no use for the cell phone, so he did not accept it. [REDACTED] fare would have been about \$25, so Abdisalan told [REDACTED] he was going to be in trouble with his employer for not collecting fare. He encouraged her again to call police so that he could obtain some kind of documentation for his employer showing that he had helped a crime victim. [REDACTED] called police to report the crime and Abdisalan only heard what she told the police call-taker. Abdisalan knows nothing else about what happened to [REDACTED] and does not want to be involved in the investigation further because he works seven days per week and cannot go to court.

Statement of Lindsay [REDACTED] (Victim):

[REDACTED] and her boyfriend, Anthony Gunderson, are homeless. They are from Oregon and have been in San Diego for about a month and a half. One night last week ([REDACTED] is unsure of the day but believes

it might have been 02/08/12), [REDACTED] had an argument Gunderson. Gunderson said something to her that made her believe their relationship was over. Upon waking up the following morning, [REDACTED] went to the Interstate 5 freeway entrance near Old Town Avenue and began hitchhiking to go back to Oregon. At about 1100 hours, an older man in a maroon four-door truck stopped and told her his son might be able to help her get back to Oregon. The man drove [REDACTED] to his son's apartment at 4555 Vandever Avenue (unknown apartment number). The apartment was a second-story unit.

The man introduced her to his son, Scotty. Scotty's friend, Christian, was at the apartment, as was an adult Asian male from whom Scotty rents a room in the apartment. Scotty told [REDACTED] he would look on craigslist.com for some "kind rides" that might be able to take [REDACTED] back to Oregon [REDACTED] explained to me that "kind rides" are marijuana smokers who post their intentions to travel somewhere on craigslist.com because they do not like to travel or smoke marijuana alone). The group of five people talked and watched television for several hours before Scotty's father and Christian left the apartment. [REDACTED] went to sleep on the living room couch.

The next morning at about 0600 hours, Scotty woke [REDACTED]. Christian and Scotty's father were in the living room with them. Scotty told [REDACTED] that she was going to have to earn her way back to Oregon. [REDACTED] asked Scotty what he meant. Scotty told [REDACTED] she was going to have to make him some money by letting men do whatever they wanted to her body. Scotty mentioned that he owed the Asian male \$1,000 and she could start working on her debt after his debt was paid off. [REDACTED] said she did not want to be involved in whatever Scotty was talking about, and she stood up from the couch. Christian, a large Hispanic male, stood in front of the apartment's exit door and Scotty said, "You're not going anywhere," as he pushed her back down on the couch. [REDACTED], who is intimidated by men due to a past history of abuse, became afraid by Scotty pushing her and Christian blocking the exit with his body that she would be harmed if she did not comply.

Scotty placed some clear salt-like crystalline material on a piece of tinfoil and used a lighter to heat the tinfoil's underside. Using a broken pen as a straw, Scotty inhaled the vapors of the heated substance. [REDACTED] does not know what the substance Scotty was smoking was because she only smokes marijuana. Scotty told her to use the straw to inhale the vapors also, and because she was afraid of him, she did so. After smoking the substance, [REDACTED] felt like her mind was racing and she could not stop speaking. She also felt like she had no control over her body.

Christian drove [REDACTED] to a Goodwill store where he bought her a lacy black shirt, a miniskirt, shoes, a bra, and thong panties. Christian drove [REDACTED] back to the apartment and Scotty gave her a black Cricket cell phone. Scotty explained that the cell phone was for business purposes only and told her men would be calling and sending text messages to it. Scotty said he would use the phone to respond to text
