10:45-Called 911 for domestic dispute involving physical violence between resident and his spouse. Per the resident, he was attempting sexual relations with Mrs. and she became disoriented as to who he was and began fighting him off of her. He was only trying to protect himself from her attacking him and he was leaning over on top of her only to try to pull the call light. He said the redness on her lower right jaw and ear came from that or a possible fall. He said that she was trying to set him up to look like he hurt her because she admitted that she had intercourse with another resident and was trying to cover it up. He became tearful and said that he would never mean to hurt her or anyone and that he understands that he has to go to the hospital to get things fixed.

11:25-San Diego PD transported resident to Pomerado ER to be evaluated on a 72 hour psych hold. Resident was compliant when escorted away from the facility by police car.

11:35- Notified daughter Claudia. She expressed frustration stating that she could not understand why these incidents always happen at night and that just makes no sense to her. Her voice was elevated and strained and she wanted to know why we couldn't send her Mother to jail instead and give her Dad a break. She said it's not fair that he always get blamed when things go wrong. I explained to her that the decision to send her Father rather than her Mother was based on the fact that he had no visible injuries and denied any injury, pain or violence to his person. Her Mother, however did have visible signs of injury to her face and ear and as recounted by both residents that he was trying to have sex with her and she thought that she was being raped by a stranger so she struggled to get out from beneath him. He tried to contain her and when he was not able to she fled to ask for help. She told me that it was late and she would not be going to the hospital to see him and that we could handle it.
